

||:Melody, Harmony, Rhythm:|| - 1.6

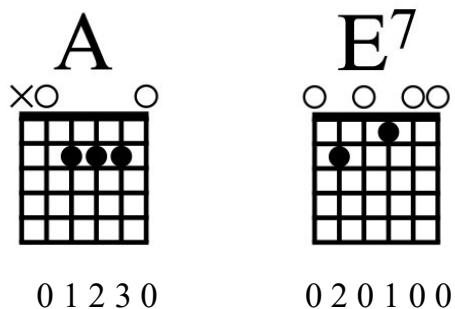
In order to play the guitar properly, it's important to understand what the guitar is capable of doing. Therefore, you need to understand the following three things.

Melody- singing (or playing the melody)

Harmony- positions of chords with the left hand

Rhythm- strumming with your right hand

CHORD CHART – 1.7



The black dots indicate where your fingers will be placed.

The numbers below the chord chart tell you which fingers to use.

“X” over a string means the string will not be played.

“O” over a string means to play it open.

NOTE:

Pay close attention to which fret your fingers will be on.

The “A” chord is on the 2nd fret of the guitar. See image on the next page for what the A chord looks like on the guitar.
